Order of High Court of Madras regarding Scheduling & System Operation charges <u>– applicability to REC machines</u>

As you are aware IWPA got a stay regarding the Scheduling and System Operation Charges which is now being levied @ Rs. 300 irrespective of the capacity.

The benefit of the Court order was not given by TANGEDCO to REC machines. Therefore, we had obtained a letter from our legal counsel, Mr. Rahul Balaji that the general order is applicable to REC machines as well and the same levy of Rs. 300 would have to be levied on REC machines.

The letter addressed by our legal counsel, Mr. Rahul Balaji to TANGEDCO is attached for your kind perusal.

We had submitted this letter to TANGEDCO yesterday and the Chief Financial Controller TANGEDCO told us that a decision would be given only on Monday i.e. September 7.

We hope to get a positive order. We will keep you informed as soon as we get the decision from TANGEDCO on Monday.
