Sub: Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission's Consultative Paper with Regard to Tariff Order for Forthcoming Control Period Commencing on 01/04/2020

TNERC has released a consultative paper with regard to the Tariff Order for the forthcoming control period commencing on 01/04/2020. The consultative paper and a gist prepared by Mr. Muthusamy, Legal Consultant, IWPA, are attached. Some key elements are:

- No banking in respect WEGs that are 10 or more years old
- For WEGs that are less than 10 years old:
 - Consumption within the same month
 - Where consumption is less than generation, credit of 75% of the applicable tariff, adjusted against current consumption charges or payment within 30 days. OR
 - No drawal of banked energy during evening peak hours.
 - Banking only from April to December.
 - No banking from January to March
 - Where consumption from April to December is less than generation, encashment @ 75% of the applicable tariff / 75% of Pooled cost of power purchase for captive generators under REC scheme
- No banking of energy for third party power purchase.
- Transmission, wheeling and scheduling and system operation charges at 100% of that applicable for conventional power. This is currently 47 paise per unit. This will become 94 paise per unit.
- Actual line losses in kind
- 100% of cross subsidy surcharge of that applicable to conventional power. This is currently Re 1.00 per unit. This will become Rs 1.67 per unit.
- 25 paise per kVARh will be levied on wind energy generators, who draw reactive power up to 10% of the net active energy generated. Anyone drawing in excess of 10% of the net active energy generated will be liable to pay double the charge.
- Start-up power: Drawal of energy by the wind generators during the start up from the distribution licensee shall be adjusted against the generated energy.
- WEGs who opt for parallel operation with the grid shall pay 100% of applicable parallel operation charges to the distribution licensee. This is not applicable to open access consumers.

All WEG owners are requested to positively write directly to TNERC, preferably on or before March 4, 2020

- Seeking to retain April-March banking for all WEGs, irrespective of age and
- 2. Objecting to the proposal to increase transmission, wheeling, system operation and scheduling charges and cross subsidy to 100%, on par with conventional energy, as it is not in line with the Electricity Act.

Members are requested to mark a copy to IWPA in order to enable us consolidate and put forward the views of the Association.
