Amendment in IWPA Bye- laws

All the National Council members including the office bearers, contribute to the functioning of IWPA, purely on an honorary basis. Sometimes, a few National Council Members are unable to attend the meetings held at various cities due to their prior commitments. As per the Bye Laws, lack of attendance leads to disqualification for six years from being a member of the National Council.

IWPA Bye Law under "Quorum" states that *"If a National / State Council Member ceases to be member because of lack of attendance twice at the meetings, he stands disqualified for 6 years from contesting for the Council / Office Bearer in future."*

The National Council can ill afford to lose their valuable contribution to the deliberations in the National Council and State Council meetings. Therefore, in the larger interests of the Association, the National Council in its meeting held at Jaipur on June 20, 2018 has proposed the removal of this clause which stipulates disqualification.

Members are requested to give their approval for the proposed amendment in the Bye Law in the forthcoming AGM to be held on 4th August 2018.
