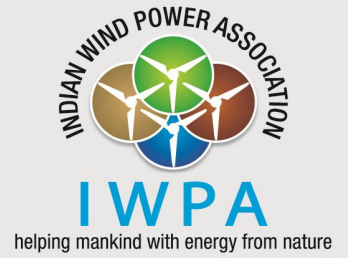

Circular to Members having wind mills in Tamil Nadu

Dear Member,

Sub: Substation and Transmission Lines Rectification – Proposed memorandum from IWPA to the Government of Tamil Nadu and TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO

One among the problems leading to curtailment of wind energy is breakdown and equipment failure at substations owned and operated by TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO.

It is learnt that the Government has indicated its seriousness in rectifying faults in the electrical transmission and distribution system. In this context, it is proposed to submit a memorandum from IWPA to the Government as well as TANGEDCO/TANTRANSCO. Accordingly, we request members who are facing curtailment on account of breakdown and equipment failure to furnish the following information to us on or before June 26, 2021:

Name of Member	Name of Substation	Power Transformer failure to be replaced with capacity and date of such failure	Feeder breaker failed and to be replaced with failed date	Any other major breakdown yet to be rectified
